The Village sends out newsletters occasionally to keep you up to date on the happenings at the resort. If you have an e-mail address that you would like to receive your newsletters through, please e-mail the same to rvbeaverflat@gmail.com. This e-mail may also be used for invoices and other village happenings. Your e-mail address is not given out. As well, some of the other Committees deliver news about events taking place in the Village to your house/cabin. We encourage property owners to place a mail box on their cabin for this purpose.

Village residents may rent the Hall for get togethers, anniversaries or any other occasion at a cost of \$250 per day. Arrangements for this should be made through the Administrator.

The Village rents a garbage bin and a recycling bin from Triways. The garbage bin is placed at the west end of the Village and the recycling bin is near the Hall.

If you are wishing to have custom work completed (ie: rototilling your garden, etc.) please contact the Administrator. We can assist you with most of the custom work you have, at a charge.

Our water system is usually turned on some time at the beginning to middle of May (depending on the weather) and is turned off around the end of September. **Please remember that this water is not potable and is intended for watering lawns, washing vehicles and such.**

The Village offers a 5% discount on taxes if you pay the full amount on or before July 31st of the current year. This discount applies only to the municipal taxes and does not apply to the school, water levy, garbage levy or any local improvements.

A boat sticker is offered free of charge to property owners and can be obtained by contacting the Village Office. Storage sites for boats, recreational vehicles, etc are available for \$100 per year. Please contact the Administrator if you wish to arrange for a storage site.

On-line payments can be made through the Credit Union (the Village banks with Innovation Credit Union) or by e-transfer through other banking institutions. Please use your first initial and last name as your account number. Otherwise you may mail a cheque to the Resort Village address.

As with any organized Village there have to be some rules. We try to keep them short and simple. We ask that residents use common sense in their consideration toward other residents, thus decreasing Council's need to intervene. A document highlighting some of the bylaws of the Village is attached. If there are any copies of bylaws that you wish to have, please contact the Administrator.
